## From the Principal

Last Monday our annual swimming carnival was held in what could only be described as appalling conditions. In spite of the constant rain, combined with no free swim (aquatic centre policy), the day was another resounding success due in no small part to the wonderful participation rate and enthusiasm of the students. All students who swam on the day in any of the events are to be congratulated and commended for their effort. My congratulations and thanks also go to the staff who spent most of the day in the rain undertaking their roles with dedication. A special thank you must go to Mr. Rodgie and his assistants for organising the carnival. It is a credit to all involved that the carnival ran so efficiently under such difficult circumstances. The results from the carnival are reported later in this newsletter.

The Prefect induction, which was postponed from last year, was held today. Due to the inclement weather it was necessary to hold the ceremony in the school hall. Proud family members, friends and students from years 7, 11 and 12 were present. Congratulations to all the prefects for 2008. We are sure that our new prefect body will equal or exceed the excellent standards set by their predecessors. (We already acknowledge their supremacy in the area of dance.)

Next week will be the first "normal" week of the school year. Things have been very busy with a number of important activities and events. This has created some disruption, however I have been impressed with the way the students have settled into the new school year. It is especially pleasing to see how well our new students in the school are adapting to the new environment.

Even at this early time of the year it is important that students organise themselves into a regular pattern of doing school work. This approach will assist them greatly not only in being prepared for future tasks and tests, but will also assist in developing good work habits for the longer term. It is especially important that students "get the balance right" ensuring that each dimension of their lives gets its due time.

Next Tuesday the first meeting of the P&C will be held in the school library commencing at 8 pm. I encourage all parents, in particular our new parents, to come along and to be involved in our school. As is traditional the Year 7 adviser – Ms Levy – will be in attendance to discuss the role of the year adviser.

The fees/contributions are currently being set for 2008

and the payment sheet for years 8 – 12 will be distributed soon. Please be assured that increases for this year will be kept to a minimum. When you receive your fees/contributions sheet your prompt payment of these fees/contributions would be greatly appreciated as we have already budgeted for your money coming in. Please note that the money collected is spent on improving the education of our students.

It is important that student record cards be returned to the school as soon as possible. Thank you to those students who have already done so. I remind you also of the need to inform us if your son suffers from severe allergic reactions (anaphylaxis) or other significant medical condition(s).

Hornsby Shire Council has written to the school asking us to inform parents that their rangers will be patrolling the roads around schools and issuing infringement notices to those who fail to abide by the relevant traffic rules. A table listing typical infringements and penalties is included later in this newsletter. The safety of our children and young people is the highest priority.

Whilst on the issue of traffic please do not drive into the school past the visitor car park as it makes it difficult for entry and exit of staff and other authorised vehicles. Simple traffic rules, such as give way to cars turning left if you are turning right into the driveway, need to be observed if you are planning to drive into the visitors' car park.

The P&C takes out accident insurance on behalf of students. Should a student be injured at school then some out of pocket expenses may be claimed. Application forms are available from the front office should the need arise.

The selection process for a new Principal for our school is nearing completion. We expect a decision will be made in the very near future.

## P & C NEWS

**Welcome back and welcome to Year 7 students and parents**

For all returning students and their families the P&C wishes you a successful year and trusts you continue to find the continual improvement that you seek. To the parents and guardians we look forward to your continued support of the school through the P&C. This, the 50<sup>th</sup> year promises to be very interesting and

rewarding for those who continue or begin to get involved. It's never too late!

I had the pleasure of addressing the new Year 7 parents at their orientation camp last week. I was made very welcome by the parents I spoke with and I must thank them for the feedback they freely provided. Thanks also to Ms Blae Levy (Year 7 Adviser) and the teachers who made the opportunity possible.

The three main points I made:

1. The P&C works with the school staff and students (with time and funds) to enable the school to provide opportunities for the boys that would not be otherwise possible. Some parents might not realise that secondary schools in NSW provide for parents to be involved though the P&C – I clarified that at 'Normo' they are both welcome and encouraged to support the boys and the school by participating in P&C activities.

2. To be effective the P&C needs parents to be involved. There are many opportunities to help. This includes: your financial school P&C contributions; supporting occasional fund raising; input at meetings; use of the canteen and clothing pool (and volunteering to assist in these); or assisting in the support of school functions. I also mentioned our pressing need to find a Secretary and a Treasurer as the sons of the current incumbents are now in Year 12.

3. Our sons need a parent's example to follow. To show leadership at home on the importance of Normo our sons need an example to follow. I asked all the new parents and guardians to reflect on the importance of showing by actions (and a bit of time) that they are involved in the school. We are all too familiar with being told to do things by those not actually doing the same so... I invited them to start their involvement by attending the next meeting which will be of special importance to them. This last matter is one of critical importance to all families especially as our boys become young men over the course of their six years at Normo. Effective role modeling at home is critical in this day and age.

To the families of students joining Normo in the other years we welcome you also. The P&C is a great way to make contact with parents of your boy's year – don't feel alone, join in!

#### **Next General Meeting**

will be most welcome to see what is involved.

#### **Working Bees**

These will feature on the calendar soon. The concept of 'attend in person to lend physical effort, or make a contribution if unable to attend' is being discussed. Any such funds would go towards plants or landscaping materials. This concept for a working bee is working in a number of schools – including our 'sister school' Hornsby Girls'. It seems a fair way of providing options for participating in improving the look of our sons' school. This arrangement will also free up significant expenditure from the school to use on learning resources.

#### **50<sup>th</sup> Year Celebrations**

This is Normo's 50<sup>th</sup> Year! We expect to be involved and planning by the school has begun. Tentative dates are weekends early in Term 2 (not Mother's Day!). More announcements to follow!
