

NBHS P & C Association Special General Meeting

Tuesday, 16 December 2008

Meeting commenced: 8.35 pm, Chair: Pevlin Price

Attendance: As per sheet

Meeting approved Helene Mountford to be acting secretary.

Apologies: Jeff Bruce (Principal).

The acting secretary explained that the Federation of P&C Associations advised a special general meeting be called to elect a president. This was necessary because, after the annual general meeting in November, the secretary, when updating the membership roll, found a number of members who had joined that evening had voted in the election when they were not eligible to vote (according to the Constitution) until the following meeting. Because the number of ineligible persons who voted was greater than the difference between the votes of the two presidential candidates, the election of the president was not valid.

Motion:

That as the previous presidential election was subsequently found to be contrary to the NBHS P&C Constitution, there should be a new election.

Proposed: Michael Miller, seconded: Meghnad Krishnaswamy. Motion carried on the voices.

Chair handed over to NBHS deputy principal, Mr John Fielding.

Nominations for President NBHS P& C Association:

Pevlin Price: nominated by Meghnad Krishnaswamy, seconded by Ross Willis.

There being no other nominations, Mr Fielding declared Pevlin Price elected.

The president took the chair.

The vacancy for a vice president will be considered at the first P&C meeting in 2009.
